Holiday "Soup and Bake Sale" - @ PPC - Sat, December 3rd


PPC's Presbyterian Women Group will be hosting a "Soup and Bake Sale" on Saturday, December 4 - from 9:00-11:00 a.m.

Worship @ Tivoli - Dec 19 - "Christmas" Worship Service


We will once again share our "Christmas" Worship Service with the residents of Tivoli on Monday, December 19 @ 10:00 a.m.

A Presbyterian tradition for almost seventy years, the *Christmas Joy Offering* is one of four special offerings designated by the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church to provide congregations direct ways of supporting specific causes that help those in need.

The receipts from the offering are distributed equally to the Board of Pension for assistance programs and to Racial Ethnic and Women's Ministries/Presbyterian Women of the General Assembly Mission Council to support Presbyterian racial ethnic education.


