We will once again offer a "Longest Night" worship service here at PPC.

The "Longest Night" service (also called a "Blue Christmas" service) is a worship experience which is offered for those in our community who may find that Advent and Christmas is a more difficult time because of losses, changes, fears and upheavals.

This is a more quiet and reflective service, which includes the "lighting of the blue candles" as a part of the experience.

Those who share in this service are invited to take part in as much or as little of the service as they need to. Sometimes just a "space and place of quiet" is important too!

If you find that this type of service may be important for you this year, please come.

Or if you know of someone for whom this service would be important - please invite them.


"A Community Christmas Cookie Baking" opportunity

If you would like to have a devotional mailed to you, just contact the Church Office.


"Special Music" - During Advent & Christmas?
