During 2022, Portage Presbyterian Church had a series of "unexpected expenses" for which we had not budgeted. These were not unnecessary expenditures, but those which needed our attention sooner rather than later. Among these "unexpected expenses" were:

Updates at the Manse (replace the retaining wall, update the original windows and original wood siding) \$43,335.52

> Westminster Center Basement (installing new flooring to replace the original tile floor) \$5475.00

> > Replacing damaged windows in church \$2481.50

> > > Per Capita

(this is the amount we pay from our church income that has not been covered by donations) \$4401.94
