PPC in Worship "Together"

As we have moved into the Fall season, we will continue to offer the "outdoor service" at 10:05 a.m. This includes the "drive in" option or the "bring your own chair" option. We ask that everyone continues to observe a "safe distance" (6 feet) between families.

In case of inclement weather (rain or temperature) - the worship service will be moved into the sanctuary - following the guidelines established by the Session (*which have been included in previous mailings*).

<u>Determination of "outdoor" or "indoor" worship will be made no later than the Friday before</u> on PPC's "Facebook" page, on the church sign and via the church's phone message.

We also continue to offer "live videos" of the Sunday morning worship services on PPC's <u>Facebook page</u>. A Few Final Thoughts ... from Pastor Dave

Shifting into a "new reality." This is what I call my thought process as I recently took some time to begin planning for the Fall. My first thought - how does one begin to plan for this Fall in 2020? Just when one thinks you might have a plan, things change.

But the other part of this is that there was a time a few months ago that we looked at this pandemic as something "short term." Now, as we look ahead we see much more ambiguity than certainty. For me, it is a "shift into a new reality." A reality in which I, and we, have never been before. And despite my many searches on Google, I have also discovered that there is no "manual" as to being a church community in the midst of a pandemic.

The "good news" is that we are not on our own in this time. Much as God's people found themselves in the wilderness of the Exodus, much as God's people found themselves wondering how we continue to exist in Exile, much as God's people wondered "now what?" immediately after Jesus' crucifixion - so God's people today (you, me and us together) have experienced that even when we struggle, when we doubt, when we are tired, when we are afraid- God is with us! And just as has been the case before, God will lead us in and through this time now.

And so we continue to move ahead, trust God and serving with "energy, intelligence, imagination and love" in many different ways and places. We have learned and we continue to learn. Above all, God has blessed us and continues to bless us in amazing ways as we fulfill our calling to be God's people of Good News!
